



STUDENT DRIVER PERMISSION FORM

Any NLCS student with a valid Driver's License may drive to and from school with his or her parent(s)' permission, subject to the following rules:

1. The attached permission form must be signed by the student and parent/legal guardian. This form is good only for the present school year and must be renewed each year. *If the parent(s) revoke their support of the student's driving privilege, the school will cancel this permission.*
2. Students must drive carefully when on the property, and obey a mandatory 15 mph speed limit. *Speeding, discourteous driving, or other dangerous activity, when reported to the office, will be investigated and may result in suspension of the driving privilege.*
3. Students must park only in the designated area for student parking. Vehicle access is "off limits" during the school day without specific permission from the Principal.
4. Student drivers are not to permit any other students to have access to their vehicle on campus at any time. Students may not transport any other persons to or from our campus without specific written permission from the necessary parents/guardians. This permission should be in the form of a notation on the *Transportation Permission Form*. *This includes regular carpool members, friends, and siblings.*
5. Students may not leave the school before their regular dismissal time without permission from the Principal.
6. Students are responsible for their conduct and actions in having their car on campus. *Articles visible in the car are considered to be articles brought to school.* Students must not bring weapons, cigarettes, objectionable music, or other inappropriate articles to school. Disciplinary procedures listed in the NLCS Student Parent Handbook will be followed for items, actions or speech that occurs in any vehicle on NLCS campus.
7. Students who drive must promptly leave their vehicle in the morning and are expected in their first period class on time. Students who drive must leave campus promptly at the end of the school day, (i.e., within 15 minutes of their dismissal). They may not congregate in the parking lot. There will be no loud music played from a vehicle on school grounds or at any school activity.
