### **Spiritual Qualities**

- Teach classes as assigned, following the prescribed scope and sequence as scheduled by the administration.
- Plan broadly through the use of semester and quarterly plans and objectives using the FACTS Student Information System.
- Provide an effective classroom management system.
- Maintain regular, accurate records to ensure comprehensive knowledge of each student's progress.
- Integrate biblical principles and the Christian worldview throughout the curriculum and activities.
- Participates in formal and informal parent-teacher conferences.
- Participate in continuous professional development through professional reading, college coursework, in-services, workshops, and training.
- Participate in staff orientation, staff devotions, and parent/teacher fellowship meetings.

### **Physical Demands**

- The school is a multi-level facility, which requires teachers to regularly negotiate flights of stairs and walk around the buildings and grounds for supervision.
- Candidates must be able to sit or stand for extended periods, operate office equipment with dexterity, and lift at least 25 pounds.
- Occasionally, the teacher must work longer hours than a typical day for events such as back-to-school night, parent-teacher conferences, team meetings, open houses, graduation, or other evening meetings/functions.
